Revised Plan: Re-opening of Pakistan Urdu School Bahrain

Dear Parents!

Pakistan Urdu School opened its facility for in-person education on 12th September 2021. We are very grateful for your patience and cooperation in setting the facility according to the number of students whose parents showed a willingness to send their children to the school.

In our previous letter, we mentioned the guidelines of the traffic light system for students' attendance. According to this traffic system, 0% attendance is permitted during the red light announcement, while 30% attendance is during orange light, 50% attendance during the yellow light, and 100% attendance during the green light.

We are thankful to God and appreciate the efforts of the Kingdom of Bahrain that Bahrain is in green alert level and allows 100% attendance.

After re-opening the school, we observed the attendance trends, decided to open the school for 100 % attendance in Green alert level as stated above.

Dear Parents, feel free to send your child to school for in-person education, and for all those who prefer to stay home, we will provide the facility of remote learning using zoom. In the meantime, we are working on making our internet facility more powerful.

Please note that we will follow all the guidelines and SOPs mentioned in the previous letter posted on 8th September 2021. The evaluation policy will remain the same as used during the 1st term of this academic year (2021-2022). In all circumstances, everyone will strictly follow the rules and regulations instructed by the Ministry of Education. The school will update the parents for any amendments and adjustments in evaluation policy or other school-related matters.
