Dear Parents and Guardians,

We are writing to you today regarding a critical matter concerning the safety and well-being of our students during their daily commute: the use of **unlicensed private vans** for school runs.

Effective **Sunday, November 02, 2025**, the school will **no longer permit access to the school premises** for any private vans operating as student transport that do not adhere to the regulations set forth by the Ministry of Transportation and Communications and the General Directorate of Traffic.

This crucial action is being taken to eliminate the significant safety risks posed by **unlicensed drivers** and non-compliant vehicles, which include:

- **Drivers operating without the proper, valid license** specifically authorizing them to transport students.
- **Vehicles not following mandated traffic rules and safety regulations** for school transportation.

As highlighted by the authorities, the use of unlicensed vans can lead to a lack of **insurance coverage** for the students in the event of an accident, leaving your children unprotected. Furthermore, these drivers may not be adhering to crucial **traffic rules** or conducting necessary vehicle safety checks, significantly increasing the risk of accidents.

We urge all parents currently using unlicensed private vans to make **immediate alternative arrangements** for your child's transportation to and from school.


